07:00 - 09:00 Early morning exercise

A magnificent network of rivers, lakes and canals – this is Berlin as well. Experience Berlin on its waterways. The excursion on a solar powered catamaran takes you from Schiffbauerdamm to Osthafen. Let yourself be delighted by a trip through the city from this very exceptional angle.
