

## TOUR The treasures of Warsaw JUNE 16 2018

## **PROGRAMME**

## 10:00 meet with your guides at the Sofitel Victoria hotel

During this 4-hours tour the guests will visit the most prominent sights of the capital of Poland - so called "Warsaw Treasures" as well as the "Frédéric Chopin spots".

We will start in Łazienki Royal Park - one of the nicest city parks in Europe, where the famous monument dedicated to Chopin is located.

Additionally, the guests will go to the birthplace of Maria Skłodowska-Curie, then to the Supreme Court and the Parliament building.

Thereafter, the tour along the Royal Route is planned with such attractions as the Holy Cross Church (where Chopin's heart is buried), and Visitationist Church, where young Frédéric used to play the church organ, mainly during services for schoolchildren.

We will finish the sightseeing with another "must see" spots in Warsaw – the Old Town and the Royal Castle, entirely destroyed during World War II and rebuilt according to old paintings (funds for the rebuilding of the castle were provided thanks to the dedication of the community), the Presidential Palace, the University of Warsaw and the Hotel Bristol as well as Piłsudski Square with the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.
